Built by the Central Georgia Railway Company in 1886 the Hotel Tybee was acclaimed as the finest resort on the Atlantic Coast between Atlantic City and Miami. After the original Hotel Tybee was destroyed by fire in 1909, the second Hotel Tybee was built on the same site and opened in 1911. It was the island's social hub during the 1920s-Tybee Island's Golden Age. Today the Ocean Plaza Beach Resort continues this location's tradition of hospitality.
